## **Program Outcomes for 2018**

In 2018, all of our referrals were from Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD). We worked with twenty (20) consumers in the Job Development Program.

The following outcomes for our Job Development/Placement Program are based on twenty (20) consumers that found employment.

- The average wage was \$9.40 per hour. (Minimum wage was \$8.30 per hour.)
- 45% were able to maintain their jobs for ninety (90) days.
- The majority of consumers were looking for part-time employment and 91% of them found jobs working at least fifteen (15) hours per week.
- 64% found a job within ninety (90) days of starting the job development program.
