

Program Outcomes for 2016

In 2016, all of our referrals were from Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD). We worked with twenty-seven (27) consumers in the Job Development Program.

The following outcomes for our Job Development/Placement Program are based on twenty-three (23) consumers that found employment and maintained it for a minimum of thirty (30) days.

- The average wage was \$9.04 per hour. (Minimum wage was \$8.15 per hour.)
- 58% were able to maintain their jobs for ninety (90) days.
- The majority of consumers were looking for part-time employment and 100% of them found jobs working at least fifteen (15) hours per week.
- 86% found a job within ninety (90) days of starting the job development program.
